Code of Conduct

Purpose

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to clearly outline the expectations for parents, players, team officials (coaches, managers, etc.), and spectators for the upcoming hockey season. Our goal is to foster a fun, inclusive, and safe hockey environment while promoting sportsmanship, teamwork, and respect both on and off the ice.

Open dialogue is encouraged between parents, players, and team officials. If issues arise, please communicate respectfully and directly with the appropriate team or Club representative.

Mission Statement

La Broquerie Minor Hockey is committed to uniting youth in a cooperative environment that encourages strong moral values, personal development, and teamwork. Our program prioritizes fun, skill development, life learning, and good sportsmanship in a safe and respectful setting.

Expectations of All Participants

Sportsmanship

Every individual—player, coach, parent, or spectator—shares responsibility for upholding good sportsmanship. Respect for teammates, opponents, officials, and the game itself is essential. The emphasis should always be on development, effort, and enjoyment—not just winning.

Code of Conduct Guidelines

Parents/Guardians Will:

- Support their child with positive encouragement at all times.
- Respect and follow the rules and expectations set by Hockey Canada, Hockey Manitoba, La Broquerie Minor Hockey, and their child's team.
- Maintain self-control and avoid coaching from the stands.
- Refrain from public criticism of players, coaches, or officials.
- Avoid the use of foul or abusive language.
- Never approach the bench during a game unless requested.
- Encourage sportsmanship and teamwork in both words and actions.
- Accept losses with grace and teach children to love the game above the prize.

Players Will:

- Follow the rules and expectations set by Hockey Canada, Hockey Manitoba, La Broquerie Minor Hockey, and their team.
- Treat officials, opponents, and teammates with respect.
- Maintain self-discipline and display a positive attitude.
- Avoid foul language and aggressive behavior.

- Commit to regular attendance and communicate absences in advance.
- Exhibit good sportsmanship and show pride in their team and community.

Spectators Will:

- Remember that children play hockey for enjoyment, not entertainment.
- Avoid yelling, ridiculing, or using bad language.
- Respect the decisions of officials and coaches.
- Refrain from harassing players, referees, coaches, or other fans.
- Promote a positive environment through encouragement and respect.

Team Officials (Coaches, Managers, etc.) Will:

- Serve as role models and leaders, both on and off the ice.
- Follow the principles and rules of Hockey Canada, Hockey Manitoba, and La Broquerie Minor Hockey.
- Maintain professional conduct and self-control at all times.
- Respect all players, parents, officials, and opponents.
- Foster skill development, personal growth, and team unity.
- Address team issues constructively and respectfully.

Hockey Canada, Hockey Manitoba and Eastman Minor Hockey Spectator Policy

La Broquerie Minor Hockey supports and enforces the Spectator Policies of Hockey Canada, Hockey Manitoba, and Eastman Minor Hockey which are designed to ensure a respectful, safe, and inclusive environment at all hockey activities.

Key Points:

- Spectators must conduct themselves in a manner consistent with respect, dignity, and fair play at all times.
- Abusive, harassing, or discriminatory behavior (verbal or physical) directed at any player, coach, official, or fellow spectator will not be tolerated.
- Hockey Canada, Hockey Manitoba, and Eastman Minor Hockey reserve the right to remove spectators from the premises and take disciplinary action.
- Spectators may be asked to sign a Spectator Agreement acknowledging understanding and acceptance of these policies.

Consequences:

- Immediate removal from the arena
- Suspension from attending future games or practices
- Permanent ban from all sanctioned hockey activities

Parents and fans are expected to be ambassadors of the game, setting a positive example for young athletes.
